FABRIC CLEANING CODES

W Water Based Cleaners

To prevent overall soiling, frequent vacuuming or light brushing to remove dust and grime is recommended. Spot clean using the foam only from a water-based cleaning agent such as a mild detergent or non-solvent upholstery shampoo. Apply foam with a soft rag or brush in a circular motion. Vacuum when dry. Always pretest a small area before proceeding.

S Solvent or Dry Cleaning Products

To prevent overall soiling, frequent vacuuming or light brushing to remove dust and grime is recommended. Spot clean using a mild water-free solvent or dry cleaning product. Clean only in a well ventilated room and avoid any product containing carbon tetrachloride which is highly toxic. Pretest a small area before proceeding.

W/S Solvent and/or Water Based Cleaners

To prevent overall soiling, frequent vacuuming or light brushing to remove dust and grime is recommended. Spot clean a mild solvent, an upholstery shampoo or the foam from a mild detergent. When using a solvent or dry cleaning product, follow instructions carefully and clean only in a well ventilated room. With either method, pretest a small area before proceeding.

L Damp Cloth

Leather should be cleaned and maintained regularly. Use a soft micro-fiber cloth or damp cloth to remove dust and grime. Tend to leather using gentle leather-friendly soaps and moisturisers; follow product instructions very carefully. Always pretest a small area before proceeding.
